

Capitalized words and phrases have the meaning given to them in the Act. The Meeting will be held at the Date, Time and Place stated above. The Board of Directors of the Governing Authority will Deliberate upon the items listed in the Agenda below. Any Agenda item is subject to discussion only, action only, or both discussion and action. All portions of the Meeting shall be Open, unless a Closed Session is held when permitted, and in the manner specified by, the Act. If the Act permits all or any portion of the Deliberation of an Agenda item to be Closed, the Governing Body may enter into a Closed Session whether or not the Agenda item below states that a Closed Session for such item is anticipated. Closed Session items may be Deliberated in either one Closed Session or in multiple Closed Sessions. Final action or vote of any matter Deliberated in a Closed Session shall occur only in Open Session following adjournment of any Closed Session. Agenda items are not required to be considered in the same order as listed in the Agenda. Any Agenda item(s) may be tabled for Deliberation at a later Meeting, or removed from the Agenda. Any such tabled or removed Agenda item may be placed on an Agenda for a later Meeting for which Notice has been given and posted pursuant to the Act.
